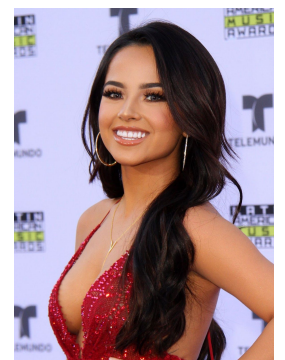
Q: For someone who is not raised here, do you think that music connects people?
